About the position

The Senior Manager of Evaluation will help refine and maintain our program data systems and reporting, including data collection, tool development, database management, data collection and privacy protocols, and tracking program outcome progress in collaboration with staff across the organization. The Senior Manager reports to the Director of Communications.

Essential Functions of this position

- Organize, maintain, and enhance data collection tools inventory, including surveys, interview questions, focus group guides
- Manage data collection and systems from in-house youth programs on schedules, as determined by Managing Director of Program and Youth Engagement Director, as well as grant deliverables and timelines
- Maintain outcomes databases and the integration of data from different sources into Salesforce and into funder databases and/or reporting interfaces
- Organize and maintain secure data system for data submission to/from partner organizations and contractors
- Conduct data analysis and prepare results for program refinement, reporting, proposals, and white papers as needed. Work with relevant MyPath program staff and research advisors to identify data outcomes to be measured
- Develop evaluation plans and protocols for data collection for specific research projects and evaluation projects
- Advise on best practices, new technologies and other trends in data collection, management, analysis and reporting
- And any other duties as assigned

Qualifications

- 3-5 years of experience supporting nonprofit social service or youth programs in an evaluation role (especially in program evaluation design, data collection and analysis, and using data to improve program design)
- BA or BS in social science discipline required, advanced study preferred
- 1-3 years of program coordination and/or delivery experience desired, can include volunteer experience
- Ability to operate in a fast-paced office environment
- Ability to work independently and seek guidance when needed

- Ability to work well in a team and play an active supportive role
- Strong project management and organizational skills
- Interest in learning and growing with the organization
- Advanced knowledge and experience working with Excel (including using multiple sheets, creating formulas, and data integrity practices)
- Knowledge and experience working with CRM systems or databases such as Salesforce, Access, government or foundation data submission systems
- Familiarity with basic social science research methods or program evaluation designs through coursework or experience
- Attention to detail required
- Ability to thrive in an environment with diverse perspectives and working styles
- Driven to meet MyPath's mission
- Ability to be creative, think critically and effectively manage setbacks
