MyPath is a national non-profit based in the Mission District that helps youth and young adults get banked and build savings, credit and financial confidence. Because we understand that banking can sometimes be intimidating or confusing for youth, MyPath strives to improve the banking system to create more youth friendly policies. MyPath Youth Leaders help shape our advocacy work and customize our financial curriculum, both of which impact youth across the country.

Youth Leadership Program Description

MyPath Advocates' New Economic Rights for All (New ERA): is a group of community youth leaders who focus on identifying solutions to support financial inclusion for youth. This means we work to educate, empower and organize to make concrete changes for youth around money issues. We will have two teams of youth leaders:

- 1) **Team #1:** This team will focus on policy advocacy and larger scale change for all young people as it relates to banking, saving and credit building. We believe every youth deserves to have access to a SAFE bank account of their own, accurate knowledge about credit and concrete tools to establish, build and increase your credit score. Being a part of this group, you will learn how to organize a campaign and you will become an active community leader.
- 2) **Team #2:** This team will deepen young people's understanding on money management and credit knowledge then present on these topics to youth in San Francisco schools and youth programs. You will have an opportunity to make a creative project focusing on youth financial inclusion. you will also help create and suggest feedback for all of My Path's curriculum. Being a part of this group, you will learn how to publicly speak and how to facilitate large groups.
